1.0 Policy

All plans for new buildings and the remodeling of buildings must meet the requirements of barrier free design contained in the state construction code, making the building accessible to disabled persons in accordance with federal, state, and or local laws and regulations. The extent of barrier-free construction required on a remodeling project depends on the percentage of floor area being altered, in accordance with state law (MCLA § 125.1352).
