1.0 Policy

The Board officers will consist of a president, vice-president, secretary, and treasurer. A majority of members shall elect a president and vice-president biennially from among the members of the board, from January 2008. The election will be by roll call vote. The president and vice-president will hold office during the ensuing calendar year or until their successors are duly elected and installed.

If the office of president becomes vacant during the calendar year, the vice-president will assume the office, as is provided by law.

If the office of vice-president becomes vacant during the calendar year, the Board may elect a replacement by roll call vote.

Note: The Board's organizational meeting should not be confused with its annual meeting, held July 1 for approval of the budget and the annual appropriations.
