Policy Statement

The Board of Education in its General Powers established by its Bylaws may take, use, hold, sell and convey real and personal property for school use, including property received by gift, devise, or bequest, for the benefit of the District.

Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to ensure the resources provided by the citizens of the City of Detroit are efficiently utilized for the benefit of the School District.

Policy

No Board Member shall be permitted to use District property (including but not limited to paper, electronic devices, envelopes, postage etc.) or the use of employees (including but not limited to full, part time or voluntary persons) of the District for the purpose of distributing or to assist in the distribution of any mailings or communications that are not directly related to official business of the District.
