It is the responsibility of the Board of Education to provide for the safety and welfare of students while at school, and in particular, safeguard their health, character, citizenship and personal development. The Board recognizes that the problem of drugs and alcohol use presents a continuing challenge in schools and a clear danger to students and staff. As such, it is the policy of the Detroit Public Schools to provide and maintain drug and alcohol free schools. To this end, the District may promote and/or implement drug and alcohol prevention and intervention programs.
