1.0 Policy

New construction and renovations should accommodate and facilitate the curriculum, programs, and modes of instruction that support the District's educational philosophy. They should meet all safety and health requirements and provide access to public school facilities to disabled persons. Finally, design and construction should lend themselves to low maintenance costs, the conservation of energy and the reduction of carbon emissions.

In addition to the foregoing, the Chief of Facilities Management and Auxiliary Services may develop other facilities development goals and promulgate procedures which effectuate the provisions of this policy as well as federal, state, and/or local laws and regulations.
