1.0 Policy

The Board will establish criteria for approval of all basic and supplementary instructional materials to be used in the public schools. It will approve and publish lists of basic textbooks and supplementary materials which meet its criteria. The lists may include a variety of choices for each course and subject.

Within budget allocations or with their own school funds, schools may select materials for purchase that appear on the list and may recommend additional materials for approval.

The Board will assume sole authority for the purchase of instructional materials and equipment. It also assumes authority to audit school inventories and order redistribution of textbooks, other instructional materials, and equipment so as to provide equality in learning resources throughout the district.

1.1 INSTRUCTIONAL SUPPLIES

Approved consumable supplies – paper, pens, pencils, and crayons – will be issued in such quantities that as may be deemed reasonable to meet current needs at the request of the individual student.
