SUBJECT: PHOTO IDENTIFICATION BADGES

1.0 Policy

The District's policy is for all high school students and District employees to have identification cards bearing their photographs so that all persons having legitimate business in the high schools and District buildings can be properly identified.

1.1 DEVELOPMENT OF LOCAL PLANS

Each individual facility will develop a plan to deal with students and staff who do not carry proper identification, for issuance of identification badges, replacement of lost or stolen identification badges, and enforcement of badge use.

1.2 BORROWING/TRANSFERRING OF BADGES

Badges may not be borrowed or transferred. Persons so doing will be subject to disciplinary action.

1.3 ENFORCEMENT OF POLICY

Local schools and other facilities shall develop procedures for the enforcement of this policy, but which do not needlessly interfere with the educational process. Exceptions shall be provided (such as one-day excuses, alternate identification, etc.) for deserving students and which do not interfere with the educational process, or safety concerns. The safety of the students and staff are always the first priority.
