1.0 Policy

Recognizing that some children are endowed with special abilities which make it possible for them to go beyond the conventional curriculum, special instruction and programs will be provided to make educational experiences challenging for them.

These programs and arrangements may include special ability classes at any level in any area, honors courses, and advanced placement classes.

The Board may establish special schools for student with outstanding academic ability and special talents.
