## **1.0 Introduction**

The School District of the City of Detroit (“DPS” or alternatively, “Detroit Public Schools”), in accordance with the Student Code of Conduct and state law, reviews all petitions by students and/or parents for readmission to DPS where a student has been expelled for a mandatory expulsion offense. The Board of Education (Board) recognizes that in certain instances students seeking readmission after expulsion may be recommended for placement in one of the DPS examination or application schools in accordance with this Policy.

## **2.0 Policy**

### **2.1 READMISSION TO EXAMINATION OR APPLICATION SCHOOLS.**

A student, who petitions the Board for readmission to Detroit Public Schools, may be readmitted to examination or application schools only if:

- a. such student has completed and submitted to the Office of Research and Evaluation the Admission Appeals Process packet requesting admission to a specific examination school, or has completed and submitted an application for admission to a specific application school;
- b. such student includes in his/her petition a recommendation from Barsamian or Hancock Preparatory Center, as applicable, that the student be considered for readmission to a specific examination or application school based upon that the student’s academic record and behavioral record (including, any special talent such student may possess) that would otherwise qualify the student for consideration of admission;

- c. the Board, upon review of such petition, concurs with the recommendation for Barsamian or Hancock Preparatory Center and makes a recommendation to the Student Code of Conduct Office that such student be placed in the specific examination or application school; and
- d. the Principal of such examination or application school, upon review of the petition, determines that such student is eligible for admission and concurs in writing with the recommendations made by Barsamian or Hancock Preparatory Center, as applicable, and by the Board that the student be placed in that school.

The student will then be eligible for placement in the respective school at such time as there is enrollment capacity. Notwithstanding the foregoing, in the event there is a waiting list for enrollment at the requested school, the student will be placed on the waiting list for enrollment in the requested school in accordance with the procedures adopted by DPS and the accepting school, and shall be enrolled in such school as recommended for placement by the Office of the Student Code of Conduct.
