1.0 Policy

Unless approved by the state board, the District may not impose any deed restriction prohibiting, or otherwise prohibit, property sold or transferred by the District from being used for any lawful public education purpose. Any deed restriction or other prohibition in effect as of January 13, 1977 is void.

If the District offers property for lease or rent, the District may not refuse to lease or rent the property to a person solely because the person intends to use the property for an educational purpose, if the intent of the persons is to use the property for a lawful educational purpose.
