1.0 Policy

The Board will meet regularly to consider any and all matters related to the best interests of the school system as a whole.

All meetings of the Board of Education and its committees will be open to the public in accordance with statutory requirements except as otherwise specified by law. Official action may be taken only at regular or special meetings.

1.1 REGULAR MEETINGS

Regular meetings of the Board will be held on the second and fourth Tuesdays of each month, at 5:00 p.m. The annual meeting in July will be an exception. Not less than seven of the regular meetings will be held in different voting districts of the school district each year. Such meetings will be held in a facility owned or operated by the Board. The date, time, and place of a regular meeting may be changed by a majority vote of the Board.

1.2 SPECIAL MEETINGS

Special meetings of the Board may be called for a stated purpose by the president, or by not less than three members. Only business stated in the call will be transacted at such special meetings.

Notice to the public will be made in conformance with statutory requirements. Notice to Board members will be given at least 24 hours before the hour of the meeting.

Special meetings will take place at the location where regular Board meetings are customarily held except as changed by a majority vote of the Board.
