1.0 Policy

The Board recommends that middle schools and high schools establish an elected and representative student government.

The organization, operation, and scope of student government should be specified in a written constitution, formulated with effective student participation. This constitution must not be in conflict with policies of the Board.

The student government should have faculty sponsorship selected by the student government in consultation with the administration of the school.
