1.0 Policy

All students have the right to the learning experiences offered by taking part in processes of decision-making – particularly when the decisions are on matters that affect both their present and future lives.

Student government, especially in high schools, is part of the educational program of the school which provides such opportunities – opportunities for leadership development; for development of skills in social problem-solving; for communications in a formal structure involving students, faculty, administration, other school personnel, and parents.
