1.0 Policy

It is a concern of the Board that before any student who reaches the age of 16 leaves school that his or her parents be aware of the situation and that they and the student be made aware of alternative educational opportunities in public school and community programs.

Efforts will be made by appropriate school personnel to discuss with the student and the parents the student's reason for leaving and the student's future educational plans.

Note: Administrative regulations pertaining to student withdrawal from school are available from the attendance department.
