

SUBJECT: **TOBACCO PRODUCTS ON SCHOOL PREMISES BY STAFF MEMBERS (Offices and Vehicles)**

Supersedes: GBK, adopted 12/9/86 amended 8/24/93

Effective: October 9, 2008

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Approved by: Detroit Board of Education

1.0 Policy

In accordance with Public Act 140 of 1993, the Board adopted the following policy on tobacco products:

The Use of Tobacco Products is Not Permitted on School Property, in any Facility or Vehicle Owned, Operated or Under the Control of the Detroit Board of Education.

A "Tobacco Product" Means a Preparation to be Inhaled, Chewed, or Placed in a Person's Mouth.

Staff is directed to take all appropriate steps to implement this policy. All employees share in the responsibility for adhering to and enforcing the policy. In the event of any conflict, the right of the non tobacco user to protect his or her health and comfort will take precedence over an employee's desire to use tobacco products.
