**ORDER RE-ESTABLISHING
THE OFFICE OF THE INSPECTOR GENERAL AND
REQUIRING THE REPORTING OF
SUSPECTED WASTE, FRAUD AND ABUSE**

BY THE POWER AND AUTHORITY VESTED IN
THE EMERGENCY MANAGER FOR THE
SCHOOL DISTRICT OF THE CITY OF DETROIT, MICHIGAN
("EMERGENCY MANAGER") THROUGH MICHIGAN COMPILED LAWS
("MCL") §§ 380.1 – 380.1853, 388.160 – 388.1772, 141.1541 et. seq., 423.201 –
423.217 AND 38.71 – 38.191, THE EMERGENCY/TRANSITION MANAGER,
STEVEN RHODES, HEREBY ISSUES THE FOLLOWING

Whereas on March 28, 2013, the Local Financial Stability and Choice Act, Public Act 436 of 2012, ("Public Act 436") became effective and was enacted to, among other matters, safeguard and assure the financial accountability of local units of government and school districts; and

Whereas, the School District of the City of Detroit's ("School District") Inspector General's Office was eliminated in 2015; and


Whereas, an Office of the Inspector General is vital to detect and deter waste, fraud, abuse and misconduct in programs and personnel, and promotes economy and efficiency; and

Whereas, the School District of the City of Detroit requires the protection and services of an Office of the Inspector General to deter, detect and prevent, waste, fraud, abuse and misconduct in programs and personnel, to promote economy and efficiency.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. That the Office of the Inspector General for the School District of the City of Detroit is hereby re-established effective immediately.
2. That the Office of the Inspector General shall investigate and audit suspected waste, fraud, abuse and misconduct in the School District.
3. That the Inspector General for the School District shall establish and maintain a confidential hotline to receive reports of suspected, waste, fraud and abuse in the School District.
4. That the Inspector General for the School District shall receive, accept and investigate all reports of suspected waste, fraud or abuse within the School District.
5. That all employees, staff, contractors, vendors, agents and representatives of the School District are hereby and hereafter ordered to immediately report all instances of suspected waste, fraud and abuse to the Inspector General of the School District to the fraud hotline, 313-870-3436 and/or by email at inspectorgeneral@detroitk12.org.
6. That all employees, staff, contractors, vendors, agents and representatives of the School District shall provide testimony and or requested documents to the Office of the Inspector General upon request.
7. That the relevant School District personnel shall assist in the implementation of this Order.

This Order may be amended, modified, repealed or terminated by any subsequent Order issued by the Emergency Manager.
