For Detroit Public Schools, 72% of Grade 3 students earned scores at the Advanced and Proficient Levels, with 22% earning scores at the Partially Proficient Level, and 6% earning scores at the Not Proficient Level.

For Detroit Public Schools, 65% of Grade 4 students earned scores at the Advanced and Proficient Levels, with 27% earning scores at the Partially Proficient Level, and 8% earning scores at the Not Proficient Level.

For Detroit Public Schools, 57% of Grade 5 students earned scores at the Advanced and Proficient Levels, with 24% earning scores at the Partially Proficient Level, and 19% earning scores at the Not Proficient Level.

For Detroit Public Schools, 55% of Grade 6 students earned scores at the Advanced and Proficient Levels, with 32% earning scores at the Partially Proficient Level, and 13% earning scores at the Not Proficient Level.

For Detroit Public Schools, 39% of Grade 7 students earned scores at the Advanced and Proficient Levels, with 24% earning scores at the Partially Proficient Level, and 38% earning scores at the Not Proficient Level.

For Detroit Public Schools, 52% of Grade 8 students earned scores at the Advanced and Proficient Levels, with 27% earning scores at the Partially Proficient Level, and 21% earning scores at the Not Proficient Level.
