



No Child Left Behind (NCLB) Public Schools of Choice & Transfer Option Program 2008-2009 Fall Session

PARENT INFORMATION AND GUIDELINES

What is a CHOICE Transfer?

This is the option that students have to transfer to a school that is meeting all of the state academic standards – that is making AYP (Adequate Yearly Progress).

Who is eligible?

Students attending a Detroit Public School that has not made AYP for 2 years or more can request a Choice Transfer.

Who will provide me with my school options?

The Detroit Public Schools Office of Title I, in accordance with the DPS Student Information Systems, will identify all of the AYP schools (making Adequate Yearly Progress) to which a student can transfer. This is a parent driven program.

Is my child eligible for transportation?

District transportation is provided for students in *grades K through 8* if the school that the parent chooses is more that $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile away from the student's home address.

How can I register my child?

Registration application forms were mailed to your home and are available at your child's school.

You **MUST** complete the application and return it to: The Division of Curriculum & Instruction, Albert Kahn Bldg., 3rd Floor, 7430 Second Ave., Detroit, MI 48202. It must be received at that office by the registration deadline, 4:00 p.m., Monday, September 15.

What important dates should I remember?

The deadline for your registration to be received is 4 p.m. Monday, September 15. On, Tuesday, September 2 the Choice Transfer will be in effect.
