## QUALIFICATIONS FOR COMPACT FUNDS

In order to qualify for Compact financial assistance, students must meet requirements that are based on the type of post-high school education you are seeking.

### Four Year College Requirements

- ☺ 95% Attendance
- ☺ 3.0 or higher cumulative GPA
- ☺ A score of 21 or higher on ACT (990 SAT)
- ☺ No major violations of the Student Code of Conduct
  - ☺ Meet requirements for college admission
- ☺ Filed a Financial Aid form ([www.FAFSA.ed.gov](http://www.FAFSA.ed.gov))

### Community College/Job Training Requirements

- ☺ 95% Attendance
- ☺ 2.0 cumulative GPA or higher
- ☺ A score of 18 or higher on ACT (900 SAT) or at the 40<sup>th</sup> percentile on standardized tests in reading and math
- ☺ No major violations of Student Code of Conduct
- ☺ Meet requirements for college/job training admission
- ☺ Filed a Financial Aid form ([www.FAFSA.ed.gov](http://www.FAFSA.ed.gov))
