GENERAL ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Only students having a strong interest in Digital Technology, Allied Health, Design Technology, Cosmetology, Information Technology, Mass Media, or Biomedical Engineering Technology career pathways may apply for admission.

The following items must be returned to Crockett by Friday, March 4, 2011, for admission consideration.

1. Application
2. Student's current report card, transcript, and recent standardized test scores
3. Special needs students must submit a current IEP

The following items must be submitted on interview date:

(This information packet will be distributed once you have returned items 1 & 2 above). Item 3 "IEP" if applicable.


4. Completed "Student Survey" form
5. Completed "Parent Survey" form
6. Two letters of recommendation from two of the following sources:
(teacher, counselor, administrator, and/or personal reference—no two from the same source)


When the student has been selected for admission to Crockett, the following must be submitted by Fall's enrollment:

7. Copy of Immunization Records*
8. Completed "Physical Examination" form, signed by physician and parent*

*A copy of the Immunization Record and Physical Examination are needed only if the student is coming from a school district other than DPS (Detroit Public Schools).

PLEASE NOTE:

 If accepted for enrollment, it is MANDATORY that all students commit to participate in a one (1)-week summer orientation program. Each student will be given a basic academic assessment as well as a career interest survey.

 Transportation is not provided for Crockett Technical High School students.

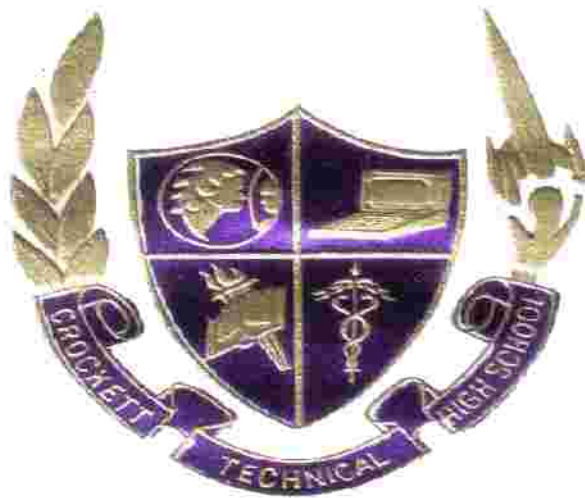
